### Camp Director Jamie Luckie

Director of Recreation program Charlotte Soccer Academy. Jamie Luckie has been instrumental in the

development of the youngest players within the Charlotte Soccer Academy program since its inception in 2009. Coach Luckie was the former Soccer Recreation Director for the Rising Stars Program of Charlotte Soccer Club. Players from the Rising Stars Program became core members of the competitive teams of CSC competing at State, Regional and National levels. When CSC merged with SCSA to create Charlotte Soccer Academy,

Coach Luckie started the CSA program formerly known as Olde Providence and has grown the membership from 400 to over 1000 players in less than two years. *"Players from all levels, boys and girls can have an unforgettable experience in soccer during our recreation seasons."* states Coach Luckie. *"With the support system in place from the competitive program directors and the clubs top level senior players, all players learn the basic fundamentals of the game but, more importantly, they have a fantastic time and that's what this game is all about."* Coach Luckie will direct both camps accompanied by CSA's full time Directors of Coaching.

## CAMP DETAILS

### CSA Recreation Elite Day Camp

The Recreation Elite Day Camp is open to all players between the ages of 6 and 18 that are currently playing at a recreation level or are interested in trying soccer for the very 1st time. Players will be grouped according to age and ability and go through a series of stations focusing on a technique for each day. The camp will make players more comfortable and confident on the ball with various games and competitions throughout the week. Prizes will be awarded to camp winners and MVPS.

### CSA Recreation All Star Camp

The All Star camp is designed for those

players that are ready to make the next step out of the recreation program and into a competitive league. Players will be grouped according to age and ability and put in an environment where they will be challenged with a series of technical sessions and programs similar to what they would receive in a competitive environment. The camp is broken into two sessions each day. The morning session will be technical training and the evening session is a chance for players to apply the training from the morning. This camp will be a great intro into what a travel player receives each week through the season.

### Who can attend?

All children 6 through 18 years old are welcome at the Elite Recreation Day Camp. Ages 6-12 ONLY at the All Star Camp.

### How do I register?

### How much does it cost?

Recreation Elite Day Camp is \$100 for the week if registering online. Price includes full instruction and a free Adidas T-shirt. The All Star Camp is \$200 for the week if registering online. Price includes an Adidas training shirt, shorts, and Adidas training ball. Applications received in the mail or on the 1st day of camp will be \$125 for the Elite Day and \$225 for the All Star.

### What about injuries?

Our key camp staff will be qualified in first aid and assist in treatment if needed throughout each day. Water and ice will also be available. Secondary accident insurance covers all campers, with a \$50 deductible.

### What do I bring?

All campers are required to bring soccer shoes and/or running shoes, shin guards and other necessities needed to play soccer.

### What are the arrival and departure times?

All camp participants must arrive 30 minutes prior to camp start time. First day registration begins an hour prior to start time. After the first day, staff will be on hand 45 minutes prior to start times for early drop-offs.

### What is the refund policy?

If a child is unable to attend the camp and at least a 10 day notice is given prior to the start of camp, a refund of your payment less a \$50 service fee will be given.
